WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

PennDOT recommends that all drivers follow Paul and Patsy's lead by removing ice and snow from their vehicles before heading out on the roadways. If ice and snow dislodge from a person's vehicle and strike another vehicle or pedestrian, causing death or serious bodily injury, the driver could be fined \$200 - \$1,000 per offense.
