



As parents, Paul and Patsy always adhere to Pennsylvania's School Bus Stopping Law.

WHAT IS THE LAW?

- All motorists approaching a school bus with its red lights flashing and the stop arm extended **MUST** stop at least 10 feet from the bus.
- Motorists **MUST** wait until the red lights have stopped flashing and the stop arm has been withdrawn before moving; **DO NOT MOVE** until all children have reached a place of safety.
- Motorists encountering a school bus stopping on the opposite side of a highway divided by a grassy median, concrete barrier or other physical barrier are **NOT** required to stop.
- If in doubt, **STOP!**
- Violators face a \$250 fine, five points on the driving record and a 60-day license suspension.

**DON'T FORGET:
AVOID HARM, OBEY THE STOP ARM!**
