WHAT DO THEY NEED TO REMEMBER WHEN “SHARING THE ROAD” WITH MOTORCYCLES?

- Motorcycles are smaller, more maneuverable and harder to spot. Larger vehicles hide their presence, making them seem to appear from nowhere.
- Keep a sharp eye out and treat motorcycles with the same respect as other motor vehicles.
- Be especially watchful when you change lanes. Motorcycles are easily lost in a vehicle’s blind spot.
- Road hazards affect motorcyclists much more than larger vehicles. Be aware they may have to make sudden adjustments to avoid common hazards.
